The Inter-American Society of Philosophy and the Philosophical Society of Uruguay invite researchers, teachers and other actors linked to philosophical activity to the 19th Inter-American **Congress of Philosophy** and the 5th Congress of the Philosophical Society of Uruguay, to be held in the city of Montevideo, Uruguay. , between Monday, December 2 and Thursday, December 5, 2024.

The purpose of the event is the presentation and discussion of research products in philosophy and related disciplines, both regionally and internationally. In addition to the contributions in presentation format, there will be the participation of experienced speakers in various thematic areas, and the holding of thematic workshops and book presentations.

Maintaining the spirit of previous editions, the congress aims to receive contributions from all areas and currents of philosophy, which maintain conceptual and expressive clarity, and intellectual rigor.

The thematic areas for sending abstracts are included in this call, without prejudice to the possibility of accepting proposals for papers whose themes do not fit into any of the established areas.

Presentations should be limited to a maximum of 20 minutes, leaving 10 minutes for questions.
